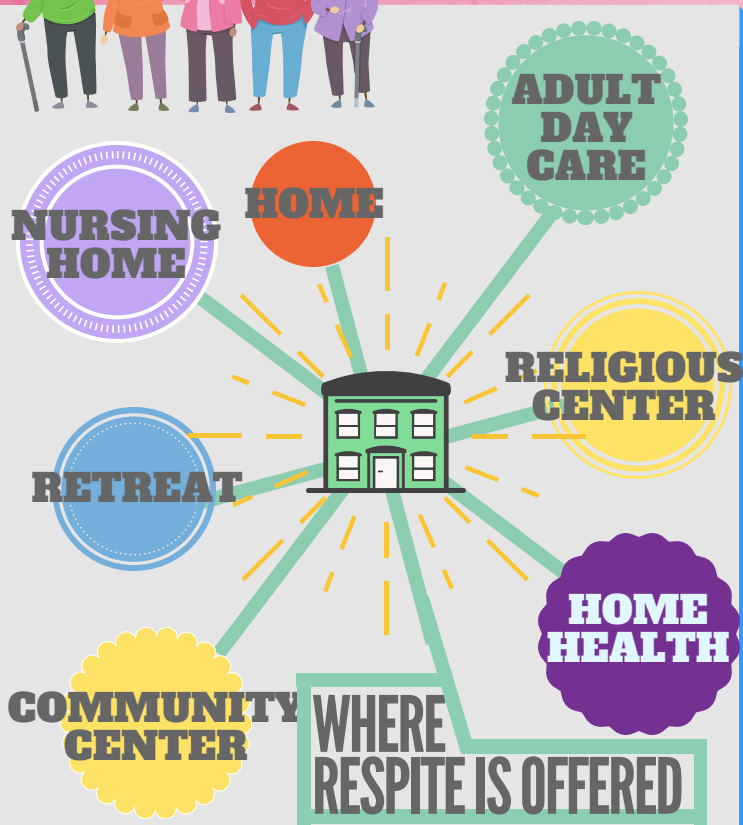


RESPITE CARE



The number of Americans aged 65+ is projected to experience a rapid increase to over 88 million in 2050. With that growth comes the need for long-term care options, including respite. Respite care is a short-term care option intended to provide a break for both caregivers and those they support to provide each party the opportunity to recharge.

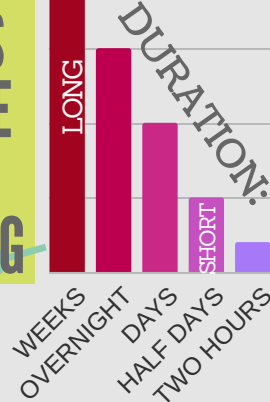

RESPITE VARIES IN DURATION:

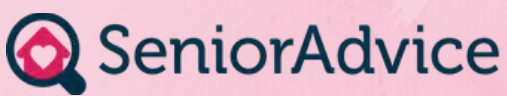
